## AWF WILL RATE ALL LABOR AMENDMENT VOTES TO S. 2123

*Republican Amendments Hope to Restore Power Back to the Workers*

The Alliance for Worker Freedom (AWF) strongly urges all Senators to oppose S. 2123, the so-called “Public Safety Employer-Employee Cooperation Act of 2007” and vote “YES” on all amendments that give power back to the American worker.

- Vallejo, CA just filed bankruptcy because it couldn't pay the extortionist police and firefighter salaries that comprised 74 percent of the state budget.
- Several states will be forced to shut-down their volunteer fire-fighter programs because of S.2123
- S. 2123 is a direct violation of the 10<sup>th</sup> Amendment to the US Constitution
- Secretaries Chao, Chertoff and Mukasey are vehemently opposed to this legislation.

**The string of amendments that could be offered, ranging from Right to Work, to Paycheck Protection, to private ballot voting for de-certification of unions all give power and rights back to the worker that S. 2123 wants to take away and hand directly over to Big Labor.**
