H.R. 6049	50	44	Senate Vote #147. Vote on cloture to motion to proceed with the Energy Improvement and Extension Act of 2008. Issue: Expansion of application of Davis-Bacon prevailing wages in federal contracting.
S. 3036 (S.Amdt. 4825)	48	36	Senate Vote #145. Vote on S.Amdt. 4825, offered by Sen. Boxer (D-CA), a substitute to S. 3036, the Lieberman-Warner Climate Security Act of 2008. Issue: The amendment expands application of Davis-Bacon prevailing wage rules to various energy contracts.
S. 3001	51	39	Senate Vote #195. Vote on cloture to motion to proceed with the National Defense Authorization Act for Fiscal Year 2009. Issue: Limits the government's ability to engage in public-private partnerships and competitive sourcing.
H.R. 980	69	29	Senate Vote #126. Vote on cloture to motion to proceed with the Public Safety Employer-Employee Cooperation Act of 2007. Issue: This bill forces state and local governments to collectively bargain with public safety officers and emergency first responders.
H.R. 2419	81	15	Senate Vote #130. Vote on conference report on the Food, Conservation, and Energy Act of 2008 (a.k.a. the "Farm Bill"). Issue: This bill expands application of Davis-Bacon prevailing wages, thus decreasing participation by small, emerging, and minority contractors.
H.R. 2831	56	42	Senate Vote #110. Vote on cloture to motion to proceed on the Lilly Ledbetter Fair Pay Act of 2007 (a.k.a. the "Ledbetter"). Issue: This bill will dramatically increase the size and number of anti-discrimination lawsuits against all employers.
S. 2663	56	39	Senate Vote #40. Vote on S.Amdt. 4097 to S. 2663, the Consumer Product Safety Commission Reform Act. Issue: This amendment expands employer litigation costs in product liability suits, further limiting the ability of business to create new jobs.
S. 2818			11 Cosponsors. Labor Management Reporting and Disclosure Enforcement Act of 2008, introduced by Sen. Cornyn (R-TX). Issue: The bill ensures enforcement of labor union financial transparency laws by fully funding the Office of Labor Management Standards and creating civil penalties for violation of financial disclosure laws.
