## SEIU President Andy Stern Visits White House More Than Any Other Person – Why?

*Could President Obama Appoint a “Labor Czar?”*

WASHINGTON, D.C. — The White House released a portion of its visitor logs revealing that Andy Stern, president of the Service Employees International Union (SEIU), met with President Obama more than any other recorded visitor between Inauguration Day and July 31. The Wall Street Journal reports:

**“Andrew Stern visited the White House 22 times between Inauguration Day and July 31, meeting with President Barack Obama seven times and leading all visitors recorded during that period.”**

Although the visitor logs do not divulge what was discussed between Mr. Stern and President Obama, it is safe to assume that the Employee Free Choice Act (EFCA), labor’s top priority, was discussed at length. With union numbers declining, EFCA would stem the hemorrhaging and guarantee labor’s relevance for years to come.

“Visitor logs are an excellent indication of who has the president’s ear, they show who Obama surrounds himself with. Obama’s list is a compilation of all the Democratic usual suspects, big labor, trial lawyers and environmentalist elites,” said Brian Johnson, Executive Director of the Alliance for Worker Freedom.

“Stern is looking to get a piece of the health care pie and knows that in order for EFCA to pass he needs as much support from the president as possible. If Stern’s number of visits with the White House is any indication of how far Obama will go to appease organized labor, the American people should stay on their toes,” Johnson added.
