Dear Representative,

Americans for Tax Reform and the Center for Worker Freedom strongly urge you to support H.R. 6094, the Regulatory Relief for Small Businesses, Schools, and Nonprofits Act.

H.R. 6094, sponsored by Congressman Tim Walberg, would provide an additional six months for American businesses to comply with the Department of Labor's new rule on overtime pay.

On May 23, 2016, the Department of Labor issued a drastic new rule that more than doubles the overtime salary threshold from \$23,660 to \$47,476. If H.R. 6094 does not pass, businesses will have to comply by December 1 of this year. In addition to raising costs on job creators, the current timeline places unrealistic compliance thresholds on businesses still struggling to understand the new rule.

It's bad enough that the Department of Labor continues to put increasing burdens on businesses struggling to make their payroll as is; at the very least they could give employers sufficient time to fully understand and comply with new regulations.

In absence of overturning the DOL's new rule all together, we strongly urge that you support H.R. 6094.
